CONTEXT

ENAP is looking for a candidate to fill a tenure-track faculty position in public management, with expertise in public procurement, with an interest in innovation and performance, responsible practices, competition, or integrity and anti-corruption in public procurement, both nationally and internationally.

Candidates must be able to demonstrate leadership in their field of expertise. They have a proven track record of scientific production, and are able to transmit their knowledge with passion and commitment, supervising and mentoring graduate students and postdoctoral fellows in a diverse intellectual and social environment. The selected candidates will conduct innovative research and must be able to apply for funding. They will contribute to discussions on the evolution of the program and public policy evaluation function in public administration, and will share their expertise with students and various national and international partners.

QUALIFICATIONS

Candidates must:

- Hold a doctorate (or about to obtain) in a disciplinary field relevant to the field;
- Have acquired university teaching experience;
- Demonstrate an ability to teach a variety of students;
- Demonstrate that his or her work focuses on public administration;
- Demonstrate research skills, as evidenced in particular by refereed publications.

In accordance with the requirements of Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada, this position is intended primarily for Canadian citizens and permanent residents of Canada.

- A letter of motivation specifically demonstrating the candidate's ability to fulfill each of the responsibilities and required qualifications listed above.

- A copy of two or three publications. In the case of a book, a copy of the title page, table of contents and introduction will be sufficient.
- A document related to one or more of the courses taught (course syllabus, teaching evaluation, etc.).
- Links to Google Scholar, ResearchGate or other profiles (if applicable).
