ENAP is looking for a candidate to fill a tenure-track faculty position in digital management, with an interest in public management, information management, the integration of information technologies by public organizations or the use of artificial intelligence in a public context.

Candidates must be able to demonstrate leadership in their field of expertise. They have an excellent track record or strong research potential in the digital transformation of the State or in the management of digital projects within public administration and are able to transmit their knowledge with passion and commitment, supervising and mentoring graduate students and postdoctoral fellows in a diverse intellectual and social environment. The selected candidates will conduct innovative research and must be able to apply for funding. They will contribute to discussions on the evolution of the program and public policy evaluation function in public administration and will share their expertise with students and various national and international partners. They will contribute to program development and evaluation, as well as to the development of national and international partnerships.

QUALIFICATIONS

All candidates must:

- Hold a doctorate (or about to obtain) in public management or a related disciplinary field.
- Have acquired university teaching experience.
- Demonstrate an ability to teach a variety of students.
- Demonstrate that his or her work focuses on public administration and public management.
- Demonstrate research skills, as evidenced in particular by refereed publications.

In accordance with the requirements of Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada, this position is intended primarily for Canadian citizens and permanent residents of Canada.
